Instructions:

Refer to the diagram 1 below while following instructions. Read all instructions before attempting installation of Battery Buddie.

1- Clean a surface on the battery to attach Battery Buddie. Peel off the protective paper over the adhesive surface and place on cleaned battery surface. Press gently into place to insure proper adhesion. Once attached do not try to remove. Damage may result.

Note:

Surface must be cleaned of all moisture, chemicals and oil residues to adhere properly. Excessive pressure used to attach adhesive may damage Battery Buddie.

- 2-Connect the **Black** wire to the Negative post of the battery.
- 3-Connect the **Red** wire to the Positive post of the battery.

Note:

Additional insulation may have to be removed from the Red and Black wires to allow for proper contact with the battery terminals.

Warning:

Reversing the wire connections or improperly connecting Battery Buddie to the battery, will result in damage to Battery Buddie Not covered by warranty.

4- Push Test Button for color indication.

Note:

Proper colors for a good battery should be Green, Yellow, Yellow, Red. See Following Chart.

Green, Yellow1, Yellow2, Red

Yellow1, Yellow2, Red

- Good and Ready For Use

- Battery Low Should Charge

- Battery Very Low Charge Now

Red — Battery Too Low to Use Charge Before Use No Color — Battery Dead or Very Weak, Replace

5- If your Battery Buddie has a third **White** wire, refer to diagram 2 for connection. This is an indicator option. It indicates that the charge device attached to the battery is functional. Attach as indicated in diagram 2.

Warning:

This procedure should only be performed by a qualified/licensed Technician. Improper connections can result in damage to battery(s), Battery Buddie and the equipment associated with the battery(s). Consult original equipment manufacture prior to installing Battery Buddie or modifying that equipment. See Warranty.


